DIY Bird Feeder's Citrus Rind Bird Feeder Ice Cream Cone Bird Feeder



Materials

- Hollowed out citrus fruit (Orange, Lime, Lemon, Grapefruit)
- Embroidery Needle
- Twine
- Bird Seed

Instructions

- 1. Cut 4 pieces of twine equal lengths.
- 2. Thread first piece of twine through embroidery needle and knot at end.
- 3. From the inside of the citrus fruit carefully poke a hole through side of rind and feed twine through until knot is reached.
- 4. Repeat step 2 for the remaining pieces of twine equally spacing them around the fruit.
- 5. Gather all pieces of twine at top of fruit for hanging and tie one knot.
- 6. Fill hollow fruit with bird seed of choice and hang outside.



Materials

- Sugar Cones
- Cheerios
- Bird Seed
- Peanut Butter
- Embroidery Needle
- Yarn or Twine

Instructions

- 1. Cut tip off an ice cream cone with your fingers or knife.
- 2. Next thread a 10 inch piece of string through the hole in the tip and tie a knot at the end so you can't pull it through the cone.
- 3. Thread some cheerios onto the string. Leave at least 4 inches of string bare so you can hang it when you're finished.
- 4. Cover the outside of the cone with peanut butter.
- 5. Roll the cone around in bird seed until it's completely covered, use your fingers to over the gaps with bird seed.
- 6. Your bird feeders are complete and ready to hang outside.
