**For rural landowners within the City of Kawartha Lakes / Kawartha
Conservation watershed who own a minimum of 2.0 acres**

The Victoria Land & Water Stewardship Council, in partnership with neighbouring Councils in Durham Region and the Counties of Hastings, Northumberland and Peterborough, acquire, sell and plant over 100,000 trees and shrubs each year. We have ordered approximately 24,000 trees and shrubs for the spring of 2008 planting season in the City of Kawartha Lakes.

Rural residents in City of Kawartha Lakes can reserve plants on a “first-come, first served” basis.

Please consider the following items when placing your order:

1. Planting can be used to control erosion, create a windbreak, naturalize a shoreline, establish a wetland buffer, or create or enhance wildlife habitat.
2. Hardwood species and shrubs require extra care and time when planting – please gauge your order accordingly.
3. Landowners should make a reasonable effort to control weeds and other competing species around the young plants before and after planting to help them get established.
4. Landowners must agree to not commercially re-sell the trees and shrubs, i.e. commercial nurseries and landscaping companies.
5. **The minimum order is 100 - please order in multiples of 10 – some species have maximum limits due to availability.**

Pickup by City of Kawartha Lakes landowners is tentatively planned for the last Friday/Saturday of April, 2008 at the Kawartha Conservation office at Ken Reid Conservation Area.
