## WATERSHED CONDITIONS BULLETIN

DATE: September 13, 2008

Kawartha Conservation advises that Environment Canada is predicting a significant amount of rainfall over southern Ontario, including the Kawartha Conservation watershed for the next 48-hour period. A low-pressure system will move across Southern Ontario later today, bringing potentially up to 25 mm of rain to our watershed. The remnants of hurricane Ike are expected to bring an additional 30-40 mm of precipitation on Sunday. The total rainfall amounts may reach 70 mm.

The predicted amount of precipitation, coupled with already saturated soils throughout the watershed, could result in high water levels and velocities in local rivers and streams.

**While no flooding is expected, municipalities are advised to monitor low-lying areas and areas that have insufficient or poor drainage, and be prepared to respond to high water situations as they may occur.**

Kawartha Conservation is asking all residents to keep their children and themselves away from all rivers and streams, as well as water structures such as bridges and culverts. These features can become extremely dangerous under these circumstances.

Kawartha Conservation will continue to monitor the situation on a 24-hour basis and will inform the public and watershed municipalities of any changes. If you are concerned about, or are aware of flooding, please contact Kawartha Conservation at 705.328.2271 or 705.344.0155 after hours.
